



Cory Streisinger

Oregon Insurance Commissioner. Was NG's top lawyer as gov. Later served same role for NG pal Mike Thorne at Port of Portland.

Bob Ames

Former bank president served as NG assistant in Washington, D.C. Later was president of the Port Commission.

Fred Miller

Was top bureaucrat under Gov. Goldschmidt. Later senior veep at PGE. Split when NG and Texas Pacific announced bid for PGE.

Betsy Welch

City Hall aide later named to TriMet board and Multnomah County judgeship by NG.



Ater Wynne

Politically connected law firm won Goldschmidt sweepstakes in 1991 when NG needed an office. Partners Steve Wynne, Bill Campbell and Steve Stadum (now a bigwig at OHSU) handled the rainmaker.

Gregg Kantor

Rising star at NW Natural under Mark Dodson. Big wheel in Portland Business Alliance. Was press secretary for Gov. Goldschmidt.



Irving Levin

Credit-card tycoon. Met NG when looking to move business to Oregon. Later made NG one of the directors of his company Renaissance Bankcard Services. NG made millions when Levin sold the company.

Diana Goldschmidt

PacifiCorp executive married NG in 1994. Served as interim Portland schools super. Named to Oregon Investment Council by Gov. Kitzhaber. Forced to resign by Kulongoski last year.

Steve Goldschmidt

Younger brother. Fired last month after stormy tenure as HR director of Portland Public Schools. Like NG, was student body prez at U of O.



Glenn Jackson

Preceded NG as Oregon's most powerful figure. Former longtime Pacific Power chairman and state transportation czar was NG's role model.

Ron Saxton

Ater Wynne lawyer. Hired Diana Goldschmidt as interim school super when he was chair of school board. Later launched his 2002 Republican campaign for governor at NG's home.

David Bragdon

Metro Council prez. Was intern to NG at City Hall, followed him to D.C. Worked on NG campaign for gov. Also worked at Nike and for NG pal Mike Thorne at the Port.

Jeff Grayson

Disgraced pension fund manager was Portland's moneyman in '80s and '90s. Goldschmidt, a pal, was one of only two Democrats whose picture adorned the wall of fame in Grayson's office (Sen. Ron Wyden was the other).

Peter Stott

Former Crown Pacific lumber CEO got startup cash from NG client Bechtel. Kept NG on retainer. Also a client of Brian Gard.



Bernie Giusto

Multnomah County sheriff. Was bodyguard and driver for Gov. Goldschmidt. Knew NG's secret and knew his wife.



Mike and Jill Thorne

She: aide to Gov. Goldschmidt. He: Pendleton wheat farmer and longtime pal; Oregon Senate leader while NG was gov; later Port of Portland executive director.

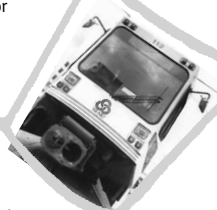
Tom Imeson

Lobbyist. Goldschmidt's right-hand man. Former Hatfield aide and PacifiCorp exec. Was NG's chief of staff as governor. Later NG's business partner and liaison to Gov. Kulongoski.



Tom Walsh

Homebuilder. Ran for City Council with NG in 1969, pal ever since. Oversaw TriMet, a NG fiefdom, in the 1990s. One of NG's partners in Texas Pacific's PGE takeover.



Ruth Ann Dodson

Confidante and alter ego to NG throughout his career from City Hall to Washington, D.C., and Salem. Married to Mark.

Mark Dodson

CEO of NW Natural. Ran Board of Higher Ed for NG. Brought NG into Ater Wynne law firm. Owns vacation home with NG sidekick Tom Imeson. Married to Ruth Ann.

John Carter

Consultant. Former Bechtel senior exec from Pendleton. Bought Yamhill winery with NG. Works for NG's former firm. On NW Natural's board of directors.



Ted Runstein

Lawyer. Was Legal Aid lawyer with NG in the 1960s before joining politically powerful firm Kell Alterman. Represented NG in 1994 settlement with statutory rape victim.

Homer Williams

Pearl District developer is longtime buddy. NG honeymooned at his Caribbean resort, Jumby Bay. NG represented key landowners in South Waterfront, where Williams is doing massive development.



Harold and Arlene Schnitzer

Wealthy real-estate and art couple were longtime supporters. NG frequented their Gearhart beach house after 1990 divorce.

Angus Duncan

City Hall aide to Mayor Goldschmidt. Later led Northwest Power Planning Council.

Gerard Drummond

Chairman, Oregon Investment Council. Former PacifiCorp exec appointed to OIC by Gov. NG. Relationship cooled over Drummond's criticism of Diana Goldschmidt.

Len Bergstein

Master spin doctor. Worked for NG in City Hall and Salem. Next-door neighbor until last summer. Relationship cooled in recent years.



Dennis Lindsay

High-powered lawyer and longtime NG advisor.

Brian Gard

Spinmeister who worked closely with NG to protect SAIF. Summoned *Oregonian* brass to his office for Goldschmidt's "confession" in May 2004.



Phil Knight

Nike founder hired fellow U of O alum NG to head Nike's international sales. Provided NG first real wealth. Big campaign contributor and big client.
